WE WELCOME on page 14 the adverts for two Independent cinema clubs satisfying the needs of eager local cinema-goers. The future of the half-demolished cinema in central Ealing remains unclear with construction started, stopped, then recently re-started, now rumours of a re-possession by an Irish bank and a possible compulsory purchase by the Council or a property developer. It is certainly time for some action on this important area and EA+L supports CEPAC (Campaign for an Ealing Performance & Arts Centre). See [www.cepac.org.uk](http://www.cepac.org.uk).

The Council and others have promoted the idea of a 'Cultural Quarter' to include the cinema site and adjoining areas of land. This project should also examine the inclusion of an Arts Centre to provide performance space for music, dance, art, film, comedy, exhibitions, meeting spaces and an Arts cafe etc. Ealing would be proud to have such a facility, which would also attract people from outside the Borough. An Arts hub for West London which would help promote the concept of DESTINATION EALING! Such a facility would be the ideal location for Ealing's Autumn and Music & Film Festivals. What about a Winter Jazz Festival once a suitable venue is available?
