A musical milestone

Local residents may not currently have a cinema, but for the last 11 years they have had the inestimable benefit of world-class classical music concerts promoted by Hugh Mather, musician and erstwhile Consultant Physician at Ealing Hospital. January 2016 will mark the occasion of his 1,000th Ealing concert.

The concerts are held twice a week or more, at St Mary's Perivale (7.30 Wednesdays and often also 3pm Sundays) and St Barnabas, Pitshanger Lane (1pm Fridays). The money raised is used both to pay the musicians and maintain the two churches. Indeed, the St Barnabas concerts have raised many thousands of pounds to pay for the fine organ installed there in 2011. St Mary's, a small, 12th-century Grade 1-listed church, was saved for the community in the 1970s, when it became redundant. Stunningly beautiful, with a wonderful ambience and acoustic, it is much-loved by both musicians and audiences. Many performances are recorded and made available online (www.youtube.com/user/StMarysPerivale).

There's no advance booking for the concerts, and payment is by retiring collection, so check out the details in the Diary to see what's coming up – and give yourself a treat.
